A Nomination is the first step for a student considering the Beacon Scholarship for University. It is an endorsement by you that a candidate fulfils the general eligibility criteria for The Beacon Scholarship, and is predicted to achieve the grade tariff typically required for a 3-4 year undergraduate programme of study (International Foundation Year, Apprentice courses, medicine, dentistry, veterinary sciences excluded) at a Beacon Partner University. PLEASE NOTE: a Nomination is not a full application. Once the candidate has sent us evidence of an offer from a Beacon Partner University, the candidate will be sent a short Eligibility Assessment Form to complete with their family; upon satisfactory receipt of this form, they will be sent a full Beacon Scholarship for University Application Form.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for the Beacon Scholarship, the candidate will need to:

- Have obtained an offer from a Beacon Partner University. 1.
- 2 Be a national of and ordinarily resident in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, or South Africa from a previously disadvantaged community.
- 3. Show leadership capabilities
- 4. Have the capacity and emotional maturity to study independently overseas.
- 5. Show a commitment to the development of their home country.
- 6. Have verifiable financial need (annual gross household income not exceeding US\$100k or local equivalent).
- 7. Demonstrate an intention to return to their home country in a leadership position, if possible after gaining international experience in their chosen field.

FUNDING

The Beacon Scholarship for University is aimed at students from middle income households. The scholarship covers full tuition fees only. Recipients are responsible for covering maintenance costs which include living costs such as accommodation and subsistence, compulsory UK government surcharges, and airfares to and from their home country. These maintenance costs are typically around £15k (US\$20k) annually.

Award recipients must open an Education Fund bank account and deposit in it a minimum balance of £15k (US\$20k) for the first year. For the second and subsequent years, a statement from the Education Fund bank account showing a minimum balance of £15k (US\$20k) is required for scholarship continuation. Parents of successful candidates will be required to complete a Financial Disclosure. It is unlikely that parents/guardians/sponsors with an annual gross household income above US\$100k will qualify.

BEFORE YOU NOMINATE

- Candidates should submit their UCAS applications by 31 December to give them the best chance of obtaining UCAS offers before Beacon deadlines.
- A Head's Nomination should be submitted after candidates have made their UCAS applications.
- Once the Candidate receives an offer from a Beacon Partner University, eligibility will be established and then the application process can commence.

Please consider carefully your candidate's eligibility – both candidate quality AND ability of candidate's family to pay living costs as described above.
