## To: School Head

Your Nomination is the first step for a student considering a Beacon Changemakers School Scholarship. It is an endorsement by you that a candidate fulfils the eligibility criteria for a Beacon Changemakers School Scholarship. For more information see [www.beaconchangemakers.com](http://www.beaconchangemakers.com). PLEASE NOTE: a Nomination is not a full application. Candidates deemed eligible will be invited to complete a full Application Form. An early submission of this Nomination Form is recommended so that a full Application Form can be sent and completed by the Deadline Date.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for a Beacon School Scholarship, the candidate will need to:

1. Be a national of *and* ordinarily resident in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia or South Africa (see [policy statement for candidates from SA](#)) and be aged 13-18 years.
2. Show leadership capabilities:
  - (a) **Academic excellence:** as a general guide, grades should be in the top decile (10%) of performance in an applicant's age or peer group.
  - (b) **Achievement in sport, music or drama:** demonstrate that they are more than just an active participant in sport, music or drama, with some formal level of proficiency or accreditation.
  - (c) **Social influence and communication:** must have held a position of responsibility in their school or, failing that, provide some evidence of confidence amongst peers.
  - (d) **Citizenship:** show through examples that they have helped those less fortunate than themselves, or have done work in the community, and are seen as role models. Unselfishness, kindness and concern for others are key criteria for Beacon Changemakers.
  - (e) **'Changemaker':** demonstrate with examples that (1) They have the capacity to 'take people with them', and (2) They are already making a difference *now*, not at some future point in time.
  - (f) **Other factors:**
    - Integration potential (which necessarily involves consideration of the applicant's competence in English)
    - The likely contribution of the applicant to all areas of school life
    - Commitment to contribute to the development of their home country
    - Verifiable financial need (annual gross household income not exceeding US\$80k or local equivalent)

## FUNDING

The award of a Beacon Changemakers School Scholarship is for up to **two thirds of tuition fees** (including boarding where applicable, and *excluding extras*). BET will pay one third and the Beacon Partner School will pay one third. Parents/Guardians/Sponsors are required to cover one third.

The Beacon Changemakers School Scholarship is designed as a 'Joint Venture' between BET, the Beacon School, and the Beacon Scholar's family. It is aimed at students from middle income households: parents/guardians/sponsors must be able to fund one third of the tuition fees (and boarding fees where applicable) for a Scholar, and it is unlikely that parents/guardians/sponsors with an annual gross household income above US\$80k will qualify.

Please consider carefully your candidate's eligibility – both candidate quality AND ability of candidate's family to pay 1/3 share of fees at a Beacon Partner School.
